Comments from the Audience:

Paula Cain, 222 High Street: She attended the meeting to provide an update regarding her neighbors and the chicken issue. She reported that the neighbors have removed most of the chickens and currently have approximately six (6) remaining. Council President Grandy informed her that zoning revisions are in progress and moving forward. He noted that the process is slow, as multiple zoning issues are being addressed.
